Submission to the UNFCCC consultation on the Marrakech Partnership for Global Climate Action

Dear ladies and gentlemen,

our UNFCCC and UN ECOSOC accredited observer organization IAAI www.glocha.info is welcoming the recognition of the importance of non-Party stakeholders' climate actions by the UNFCCC process and the setting up of the Marrakech Partnership for enhanced cooperation of Parties with non-Party stakeholders.

As it is the main goal of our organization to "advance innovative approaches to global challenges" we are delighted to have through this survey on the future of the Marrakech Partnership the opportunity to reflect on **existing work and its challenges** and to present some **new visions** for enhanced non-Party stakeholders' climate action.

The main messages of our submission - framed as challenges and visions - are as follows:

- Challenge 1 (related to 'Priorities and Focus Areas' section of the survey) Delivering on the
 Necessary Scale: Despite the laudable work done by the UN CC Global Climate Action team and the
 High Level champions, hardly anybody outside the UNFCCC process has ever heard of the Marrakech
 Partnership. But the implementation of the Paris Agreement needs everybody engaged. This requires
 the Marrakech Partnership to shift its ambition level towards "getting everybody engaged" and
 strengthening of MP's ties with the UNFCCC Action for Climate Empowerment and UNFCCC's Climate
 Neutral Now programs with simple and action and impact oriented messaging is indispensable.
 - Vision 1: The Marrakech Partnerships develops with the UNFCCC Action for Climate Empowerment program, the UNFCCC recognized Education, Communication and Outreach Stakeholders Community ECOS, the UN SG Climate Summit 2019 organizers, the scientific community and many other relevant stakeholders a coherent communication and outreach strategy which focuses on establishing "2 tons of CO2 per year per person by 2022" as the benchmark for a sustainable lifestyle (further reading: http://geiclimate.org/) and a wide range of stakeholders in the field of culture (especially music) rallying towards getting such a standard accepted by society
- Challenge 2 (related to Tracking and Reporting of Voluntary Climate Action') Lack of real time climate
 action data and tech support for mass engagement: There are very many people and especially
 young people, standing ready to contribute to the Global Climate Action agenda, but they don't know
 how. The NAZCA portal http://climateaction.unfccc.int/ is the brain of GCA but needs improvement.
 - Vision 2 A Global Climate Action App with meaningful and rewarding engagement opportunities on everybody's mobile device: We envisage to work with all relevant Marrakech Partnership stakeholders (especially the NAZCA Climate Action Portal management) through our newly established multistakeholder partnership GloCha on the development of (blockchain based) information and communication technology tools which will provide an entry point for meaningful and rewarding climate action to every citizen and every company and every other public or private



institutions. The tools shall help to document individual climate action and to get certified climate action impact units which will be rewarded by society through innovative financial incentive mechanisms (climate entrepreneurship/climate action impact economy) and gamification.

- Challenge 3 ('UN Secretary General's Climate Summit 2019') Turning the most important global climate governance event of the year into a unique cultural moment in human history - a deep transformative experience of global unity and mass mobilization for ambitious climate action
 - o Vision 3: In coordination with the mobilization coalition of the UN SG Climate Summit, there will be a #Music4ClimateAction campaign for unprecedented youth and civil society mobilization for climate ambition. (Young) musicians and celebrities will commit to create songs on climate action and sustainable development, there will be an Earth Music Awards online youth music video competition and a globally broadcasted EarthActionNow edutainment event the weekend before the UN SG Climate summit, bringing the call for climate action and climate ambition into the living rooms of everybody around the planet. Music, youth focused narratives from the frontlines of climate change, images and stories of #peoplepower in



the fight against the climate crisis will be collected on an EarthActionNow climate action engagement platform and brought to a global audience together with encouraging words from the UN Secretary General. One of the highlights of the event can be a global voting for the selection of a "Youth Global Climate Action Champion" who would help the incoming COP25 presidency in reaching out to youth and civil society as an amplifier of the various calls for enhanced climate ambition and action.

 Challenge 4 ('Looking Ahead'): Lack of Co-Working Infrastructure. Non-Party stakeholders working on climate action solutions are often disconnected from one another, from resources - there is a need for an enabling ecosystem!

o Vision 4: We invite the Marrakech partnership to work with and through our multistakeholder partnership GloCha on setting up a Global Climate Action Center (e.g. in New York, South of the UN HQ, in Bonn or/and in Vienna) as a global coworking space for all kinds of climate action stakeholders, providing office space, event space, cultural activities, a climate action data center, resources and incubation for climate entrepreneurs etc.



At IAAI we are strongly convinced that a significant strengthening of the climate action impact oriented systemic integration of Non-Party stakeholders in the global climate action governance system is the only feasible approach to face the accelerating climate crisis.

We are looking forward to contribute with our multistakeholder partnership GloCha fresh and bold solutions for a climate safe future


