

Input from Norway to the Research Dialogue

Norway welcomes the opportunity to provide input to possible themes for the fourteenth meeting of the research dialogue, to be held in conjunction with SBSTA 56 (June 2022).

We value the research dialogue as an arena to inform Parties on the latest research which builds understanding of climate change impacts, risks and implications for decision-making. The facilitation of dialogue between Parties, research & innovation programmes and organisations help to close knowledge gaps and strengthen ambitions towards climate action relevant for implementation of the Paris Agreement.

The Research Dialogue can prioritize themes that will complement the dialogues under the Periodic Review and the Global Stocktake.

Input to possible themes for the fourteenth meeting of the research dialogue under SBSTA 56 or future research dialogues:

- Tipping points and the oceans - irreversible changes
- Ecosystem-based solutions, ecosystem-based management and climate change
- Sustainable finance and sustainability reporting by companies in the context of climate change mitigation and adaptation
- Net-zero emission strategies and solutions, including Carbon Dioxide Removal
- Electrification and transition to renewable and low-emission energy solutions and implications on the economy and investment in infrastructure
- Circular economy, including materials efficiency, and circular material flows and possible contributions to mitigation
- Non-CO2 climate forcers, including methane and other short-lived climate forcers and their role in strategies, scenarios and mitigating climate change.
