Dear High-Level Champions for Climate Action,

In response to your kind invitation, we at the Egypt the Dream Foundation for Development and Innovation (EDFDI) are pleased to share our comprehensive strategic vision for the next five years of the Global Climate Action Agenda.

We believe this decade requires a fundamental transformation, shifting from crisis management to building a resilient and restored future. Our vision is anchored in the philosophy of "Restoring Our Planet Now," a concept we have formally submitted to the UNFCCC's "Baku to Belém Roadmap" process. This requires not only a new narrative but also a new, effective, and inclusive implementation architecture.

Our Proposal for the Five-Year Plan (2026-2030):

Our five-year plan is centered around establishing a decentralized global infrastructure for climate action capable of channeling finance and mobilizing efforts to achieve major transformative projects.

Proposed Implementation Mechanism: The Establishment and Scaling of "Climate Finance Points" (CFPs):

We propose the creation of "Climate Finance Points" (CFPs) in the capital city of every country as the primary implementation tool. These UN-managed hubs, established in direct cooperation with the highest levels of national government, would serve as a direct conduit for all actors to accelerate climate action.

Year 1 (2026): Launch a pilot project of CFPs in 10 capital cities to develop a unified legal and administrative

framework under UN oversight. This would be a key outcome of COP30.

- Years 2-3 (2027-2028): Scale up the establishment of CFPs to cover all national capitals, activating their core functions:
 - Providing direct, unbureaucratic funding (disbursed within a month).
 - Offering targeted training and mentorship to new and dynamic organizations.
 - Securing legal and professional protection for climate activists by designating their work as official, paid missions with their employers.
- Years 4-5 (2029-2030): Consolidate the CFP network, establish regional sub-hubs, and begin implementing the annual "Unified Global Projects" through this effective network.

Strategic Goals for the Five-Year Plan:

- 1. **Shift the Global Narrative:** Fully transition from a "blame game" mentality to a culture of **"collaborative action and shared destiny,"** framing climate action as a global project of restoration with benefits for all.
- 2. **Empower a New Generation of Actors:** Ensure that thousands of new organizations, innovators, women, youth, and previously excluded activists have direct access to finance and support.
- 3. **Facilitate Transformative Projects:** Create a pipeline for innovative, science-based solutions. Our foundation is ready to contribute with projects including:
 - **Green Fossil Fuel & CHP:** To enhance energy efficiency.
 - Space-Based Electricity Generation: To explore unconventional clean energy sources.
 - **GHG Cloud Removal:** To actively restore the atmosphere.
- 4. **Establish an Open-Access Knowledge Hub:** Create a global online library for the latest climate technologies, offering accredited courses in coordination with universities worldwide, to be managed through the CFP network.

Operationalizing this comprehensive five-year plan is the practical path to achieving our shared vision of a restored planet and a secure future for generations to come.
